



## DIANE MOORE CREATION SCHOLARSHIP

Application Deadline: March 6, 2017

### BACKGROUND –

This award honours Live Art Dance Productions' founder, Diane Moore, and her passion for stimulating creation and supporting Atlantic Canadian artists.

### ELIGIBILITY –

Professional and pre-professional dancers and choreographers from the four Atlantic Provinces are eligible to apply. Applicants must currently reside in Atlantic Canada and have done so for at least one full calendar year prior to the application deadline. Support will be provided for creation-based projects or workshops. Selection criteria will focus on the **creative elements of the project** and the importance it plays in the **applicant's career development**. Note – Projects involving study towards a degree/diploma or non-creation-focused workshops will be deemed ineligible. *Contact Live Art Dance if you are concerned about your project's eligibility.*

### VALUE OF THE AWARD –

The Diane Moore Creation Scholarship includes a cash award of \$500 plus a one week residency\* in a 4800 square foot Studio Loft (former Legion Hall) near Inverness beach. The residency needs to take place between mid-June and mid-July of 2017. ### APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

1. An up-to-date CV
2. A one-page project description. Please describe the creative elements of your project (ie. Is this a new direction for you, an enhanced exploration of a theme you've been developing, a project involving the broader community?). Explain its importance at this stage of your career.
3. A budget outline (**including revenues and expenses**). Please include any other sources of funds you are receiving or applying for in regards to this project. **Specify which are confirmed.**
4. One reference letter from an established arts professional – 1 page max.
5. Video support material, ie. documentation of a recent performance (DVD, USB or url). Please explain what the video is and how it relates to this project.

**Selection:** A jury consisting of three people – one person from the Live Art Board of Directors and two others from the dance community – will evaluate the applications based on their creative merit and/or community involvement and/or impact on the applicant's career.

Applications should be **received** at Live Art Dance **no later than 4 PM, March 6, 2017**

The successful applicant will be required to submit a final report and consents to allow Live Art Dance Productions to use their name for publicity and promotional purposes.
